Need assistance getting started with research or finding sources? The South Texas College Library offers self-paced videos and interactive online tutorials.

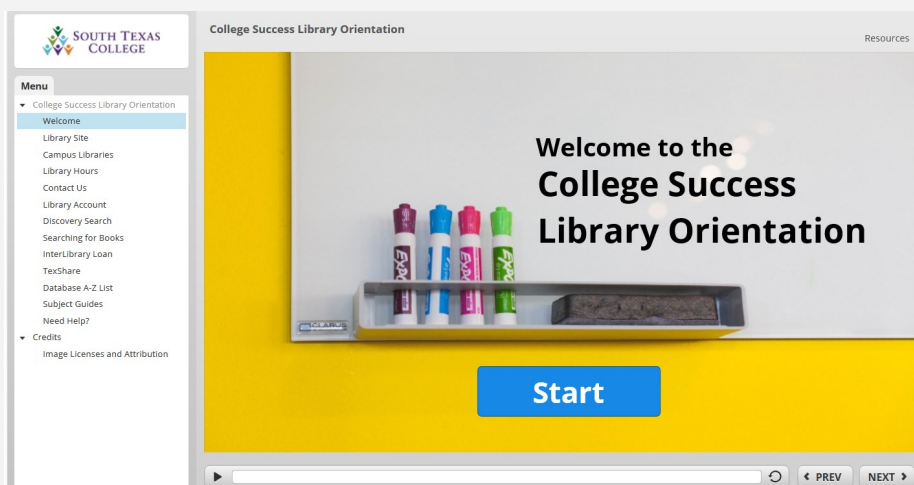
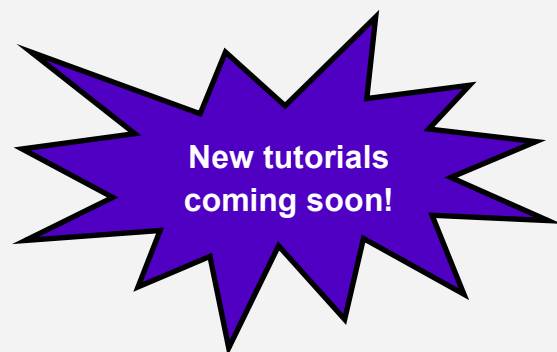

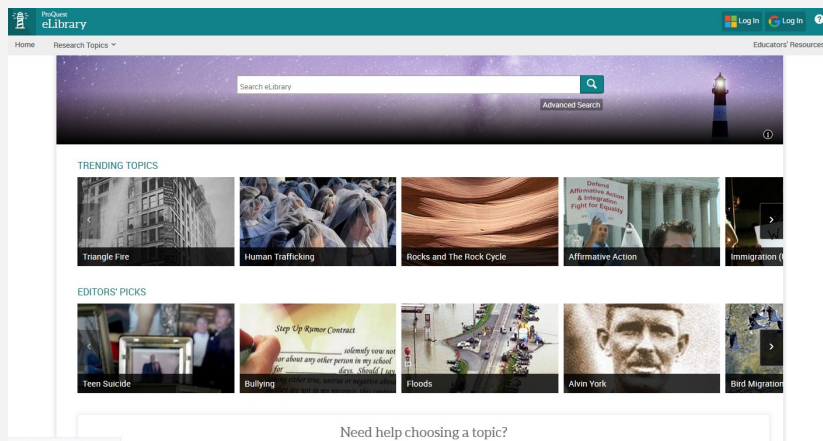

Database Highlights

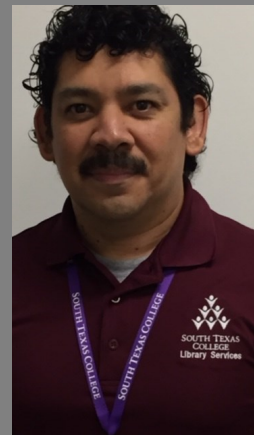
