
Did You Know...

Interlibrary Loan

The STC Library shares collections with other libraries throughout the United States. Faculty, staff, and students may request materials from other libraries if STC does not own the item through Interlibrary Loan (ILL).

Request articles, books, videos and other items. To request an item, complete the <u>Interlibrary Loan Form</u> online.

Physical materials will normally arrive at the STC library in seven to ten days. Electronic materials, such as journal articles, may be emailed directly to the patron. An STC Library staff member will notify requesters when their requests arrive or if a request will not be filled. To find out more, click here.
